NON-TECHNICAL SKILLS FOR SURGEONS (NOTSS)

This one-day course is for surgical trainees & surgeons to learn about the concept of non-technical skills in surgery. The non-technical skills which underpin safer operative surgery will be examined in detail with short talks, video simulated scenarios and small group discussions. At the end of the course participants will be able to understand the theories and research relating to adverse events in surgery and other high-risk industries. They will be able to use the NOTSS system to observe, rate and provide feedback on behavior in the operating theatre.
